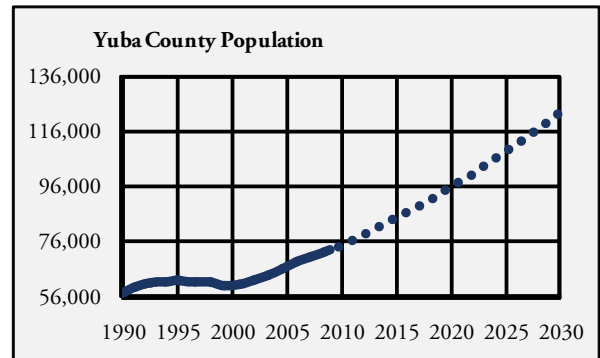


Yuba County Quick Facts
